

Byrne JAG Spending By States Across the Criminal Justice System

About this Chart

The National Criminal Justice Association surveyed the state criminal justice planning agencies (State Administering Agencies, or SAAs) seeking data on how states are spending their Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (Byrne JAG) funds. Data were gathered by the purpose area, the seven areas of allowable spending enumerated in the Byrne JAG statute.

Within each of those seven categories of spending, SAAs were asked to classify how the individual grants would be spent using a standard list of 43 topics. So, for instance, grants classified under the Law Enforcement purpose area typically are awarded by the SAA to local law enforcement agencies. How those local police and sheriffs departments plan to spend that funding is shown in column 2 labeled Law Enforcement.

The diversity of spending across the chart shows how law enforcement agencies, the courts, jails and prisons, and non-profit service providers use the funding to support a wide variety of projects and programs across the entire criminal justice system.

State reported spending in 2009. This includes the FY09 Recovery Act grant award plus other spending in 2009 which could be drawn from the state's FY09, FY08 or FY07 Byrne JAG grant awards.

Totals are shown for each purpose area (along the bottom) and for each project type (far right column.)
